- Ensuring that grievances and complaints are dealt with promptly and in accordance with our grievance procedure**
- Ensuring that the participants and their parents are aware of the purpose of videoing, filming or photography during training or events**
- Having a zero tolerance level of poor practice, bullying or any potential form of abuse**
